Affordable Care Act (ACA) Update

Congratulations to all Enroll Palm Beach partners including Health Council of Southeast Florida and Epilepsy Foundation who received funding to assist with Outreach, Education and Enrollment for Open Enrollment, Year 3.

ACA enrollments into the marketplace have generated over 136,000 plan selections during open enrollment in Palm Beach County and over 160,000 plan selections during Special Enrollment Period, for the State. Total Plan Selections in Florida: 1,596,247. Click [here](#) to see more details.

Florida Healthy Kids Program

The Florida Healthy Kids Full Pay program is currently \$153 per month per child and includes dental coverage. As of October 1, 2015 the following costs will be in effect: Sunshine Health Stars Plus: \$299 with dental, \$284 without dental. Sunshine Health Stars: \$220 with dental, \$205 without dental. Federally Facilitated Marketplace is now open. Families may choose to select a plan.
