

1. What is Minimum Essential Coverage?

- If you have coverage from any of the following, you're covered and **don't have to do anything**
 - Employer-sponsored coverage, including COBRA and retiree
 - Individual coverage (outside the Marketplace)
 - Marketplace coverage
 - Medicare (Part A) and Medicare Advantage Plans
 - Most Medicaid coverage
 - Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
 - Certain veteran's health coverage (from the VA)



What is Minimum Essential Coverage? Continued

- If you have coverage from any of the following, you have minimum essential coverage
 - Most types of TRICARE coverage
 - Coverage provided to Peace Corp volunteers
 - Coverage under the Nonappropriated Fund Health Benefit Program
 - Refugee Medical Assistance (ACF)
 - Self-funded health coverage offered to students by universities
 - State high risk pools
 - Other coverage recognized by the Secretary of HHS
